The Borough Clerk read the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Middlesex that:

**RESOLUTION APPROVING ESTIMATED MUNICIPAL TAX LEVY FOR THE
CALENDAR YEAR 2004**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Middlesex, Middlesex County, New Jersey has applied to the State of New Jersey for extraordinary aid in conjunction with its calendar year 2004 budget; and

mWHEREAS, due to various circumstances, the State of New Jersey has not set forth the final determination as to the allocation of extraordinary aid for the local units that have applied; and

WHEREAS, the delay in the aid determination has delayed the final adoption of the Borough's 2004 municipal budget, necessitating the issuance of estimated tax bills; and

WHEREAS, the issuance of estimated tax bills requires a resolution of the governing body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Middlesex that estimated tax bills are hereby authorized at 107.42% of last year's levy reflecting a Municipal Estimated Tax Levy of \$7,827,860.85 for the calendar year 2004.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Mayor and Council repeal all previous resolutions that are inconsistent therewith; and
2. Certified copies of this resolution be filed with the New Jersey Division of Local Government Services and with the Middlesex County Board of Taxation.

Councilman D'Angelo moved for adoption seconded by Councilman Mulcahy and carried by the following roll call vote: Ayes: Members Colitti, D'Angelo, Hompesch, Liana, Mulcahy and Thomasey. Nos.: None. Abstain: None.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by Councilman Mulcahy and seconded by Councilwoman Thomasey and carried by unanimous vote of Council.
