Mayor Dobies opened the meeting with the Sunshine Law Statement saying the meeting had been advertised in the Special Meeting Notice of May 30, 2003.

Mayor Dobies stated that Councilman Colin Fowler had resigned his Council seat effective May 31, 2003.

The Borough Clerk read the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Middlesex that:

Resolution #160-03

ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILMAN COLIN FOWLER

WHEREAS, Councilman Colin Fowler is relocating to Washington, Pennsylvania and will no longer reside in Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Fowler resigned from his position as Councilman effective May 31, 2003; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Fowler would like to express to the Governing Body that serving on Council for him has been rewarding experience in learning firsthand how our democracy works; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Fowler stated in his resignation letter that the greatest reward was being associated with such high-caliber people and that he leaves Middlesex in capable hands.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Middlesex, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Council hereby accepts the resignation of Councilman Colin Fowler effective May 31, 2003.

Councilman Mulcahy moved for adoption seconded by Council President Sadowski and carried by the following roll call votes: Ayes: Members Curcio, Hompesch, Liana, Mulcahy and Sadowski. Nos.: None. Abstain: None.

Mayor Dobies congratulated Colin Fowler on his new position and stated that Mr. Fowler was very open minded in the short time he had been on Council and had brought many good ideas to the Governing Body.

Councilwoman Liana submitted the names of Peter Mantel, Frank Ryan and Barbara Ferris as a replacement for the vacancy of Mr. Fowler.

Council President moved the appointment of Barbara Ferris to fill the council vacancy seconded by Councilman Hompesch and carried by the following roll call votes: Ayes: Members Curcio, Hompesch, Liana, Mulcahy and Sadowski. Nos.: None. Abstain: None.

Ms. Ferris will be sworn into office at the June 10, 2003 Public Meeting.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by Councilman Hompesch and seconded by Councilwoman Liana and carried by unanimous vote of Council.
